Ministers in Netherlands protect state secrets with Sectra's new Tiger service

The Ministry of the Interior and Kingdom Relations of the Netherlands has chosen Sectra's new Tiger service for safeguarding voice communications between ministers, undersecretaries and other senior officials. The Ministry has signed a four-year contract and the order value amounts to EUR 2 million.
